Turning off Railcom with the LH100

Step by Step Instructions

- 1. Start from where your display shows "L· XXXX" or "E· XXXX". ("X" represents any digit.)
- Go into OPS Mode Programming (Programming on the Main).
 Press the "F" Key, then press the "+" key until "POM" appears on the display.
- 3. Press the "ENTER" key. "CV" should appear on the display.
- 4. Press the "ENTER" key again. " $C \cdot __$ " should appear on the display.
- 5. Press the "7" key. " $C \cdot 7_{-}$ " should appear on the display.
- 6. Press the "ENTER" key. "C $7 \cdot _{-}$ " should appear on the display.
- 7. Press the "5" key, then the "0" key, then the "ENTER" key. "C 7 ⋅ 50" should appear on the display.
- 8. Press the "CL" key. The "50" should disappear from the display.
- 9. Press the "9" and the "2" keys, then the "ENTER" key. "C 7. 92" should appear on the display.
- 10. Press the "ENTER" key.
- 11. Press the "ESC" key four (4/4) times. The display should return to where it was when you started, i.e., "L· XXXX" or "E· XXXX".
